SEND WITH: Attach the END SILENCE State Legislative Packet whenever possible.

- Replace every bracketed field, including the legislator's name, state, chamber, district, and your own contact information.
- Keep END SILENCE capitalized in every message.
- Do not remove the central demand: FIRST CONVICTION. DEATH PENALTY. NO SECOND VICTIM.
- If you are a constituent, say so in the first paragraph and provide your city or ZIP code.
- Ask for a specific action: review, meeting, sponsorship, co-sponsorship, committee hearing, or written response.
- Remain direct, factual, and respectful. Do not threaten, insult, or speculate about an official's motives.
- Record the date, office contacted, staff member, response, and promised next step.

If implementation of capital punishment is delayed, enjoined, or struck down during the constitutional challenge, the mandatory fallback must be Life Without the Possibility of Parole. The predator must remain permanently removed from society. There must be no second victim.

- Direct legislative counsel to review the enclosed proposal;
- Meet with END SILENCE, INC. and survivor-informed advocates;
- Sponsor or co-sponsor the resolution and resulting legislation; and
- Provide a written response identifying the action your office will take.
